In addition to her media involvements and accomplishments, Jessica has shared a music ministry (2Gether) with her brother, J. Blake White. It is Jessica's vocal talents coupled with her humble and passionate heart that have opened the door to her singing background for Yolanda Adams, Donnie McClurkin, Sharon Jackson, Bishop Leonard Scott, Karen Clark Sheard, Judith McAlister, and many other gospel recording artists.

In 2007, Jessica placed in the top 10 (of 204 contestants) for the "R U Good Enough" morning traffic reporter auditions for *Eyewitness News Everywhere*.
